The role aims to represent voice the issues for Ethnic Minority Students in Hull University Union and to eliminate all forms of disadvantage for BAME students at the University of Hull.

Key responsibilities

- Represent interests of minority groups within the union by organising campaigns to address BAME issues within HUU and the University of Hull;
- Signpost BAME students on specific issues to receive help and assistance;
- Promote links with other similar groups and organisations within the local community, regional area and nationally;
- Is a member of Union Council and the Inclusivity and Diversity Zone with full voting rights.

- Good organisational skills
- Creativity
