



Chair of Union Council

Aim

The aim of this role is to provide an impartial Chair who is responsible for the proper conduct of Union Council meetings, and for promoting wider student engagement with Union Council.

Key Responsibilities

- To chair Union Council Meetings
- To attend and contribute to Governance zone meetings
- To meet with the Student Voice Manager prior to the first meeting of Union Council, in order to fulfil their responsibilities.
- To act as a direct link between the Student Voice Manager, members of Union Council and the wider student populous
- To promote Union Council activities to the wider student populous
- To ensure all Union Council members are sufficiently trained to engage during meetings
- To promote the submission of motions to Union Council by the wider student populous
- To answer questions on Union Council procedures
- To promote the evolution and continuing relevance of Union Council through consultation with Union Council members, the Governance Zone, the President of the Students' Union and the wider student populous

Useful Skills or Characteristics

- Ability to exercise independent judgement
- Ability and confidence to lead and direct meetings
- Good organisational skills
- Strong communication skills
- Good understanding of a wide range of issues relating to each zone area
- Knowledge or willingness to learn about governance at Hull University Union

Average Time Commitment
