



# Trans Students Representative

## Aim

The role aims to represent the interests of transgender students in Hull University Union and eliminate all forms of disadvantage and transphobia against trans students at the University of Hull.

## Key responsibilities

- Represent interests of trans students within the union by organising campaigns to address trans issues within HUU and the University of Hull;
- Signpost trans students on specific issues to receive help and assistance;
- Promote links with other similar groups and organisations within the local community, regional area and nationally;
- Is a member of Union Council and the Inclusivity and Diversity Zone with full voting rights.

- Good organisational skills
- Creativity
