Aim

The role is to represent women students at the University of Hull and work to eliminate all forms of gender disadvantage through campaigning and the provision of relevant information and events.

Key responsibilities

- Represent interests of women within the union by organising campaigns to address women's issues within HUU and the University of Hull and wider aspects of gender inequality;
- Signpost women on specific issues to receive help and assistance;
- Promote links with other similar groups and organisations within the local community, regional area and nationally;
- Is a member of Union Council in the Inclusivity and Diversity Zone with full voting rights.
